

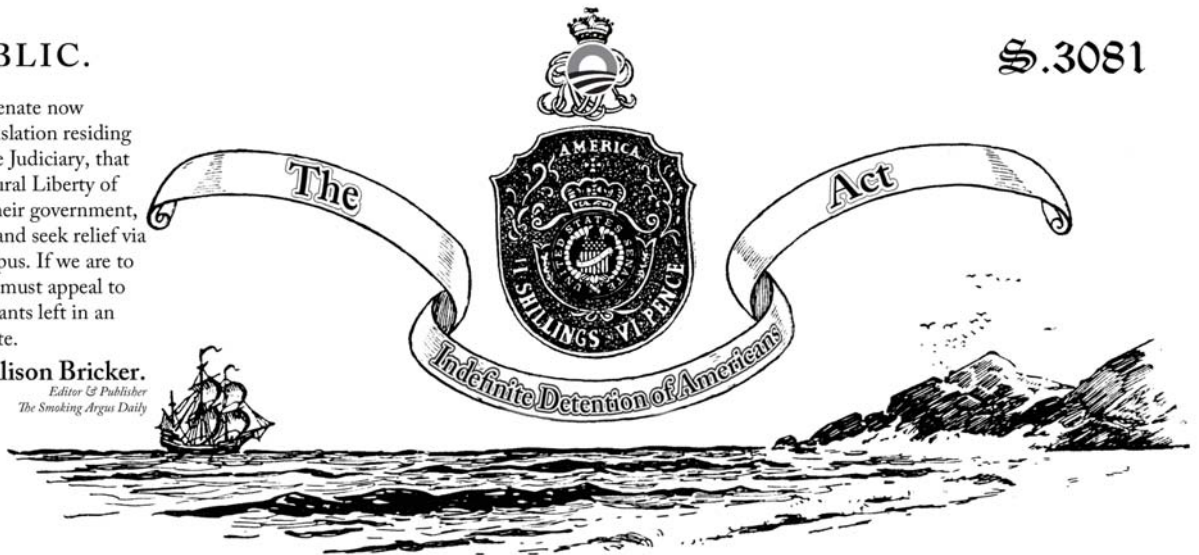

Senator John McCain from Arizona has authored **S.3081 "Enemy Belligerent Interrogation, Detention, and Prosecution Act of 2010"**. This bill seeks to circumvent the U.S. Constitution by utterly usurping our NATURAL RIGHTS delineated by the 1st, 4th, 5th, 6th, and 9th Amendments. 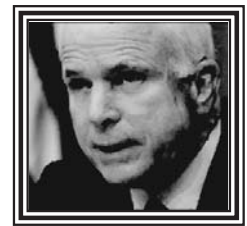

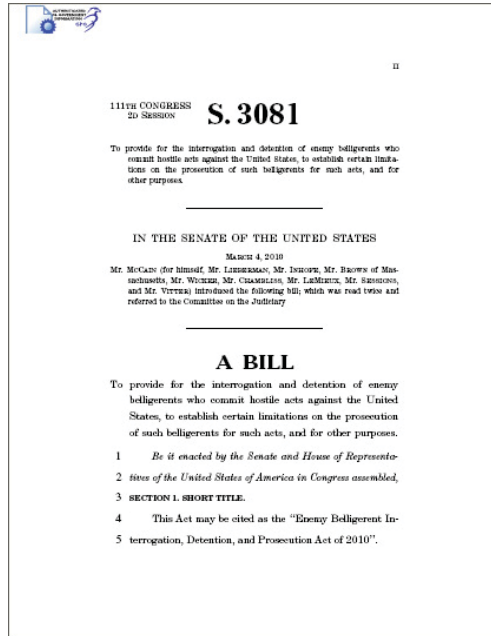
